Innovate financing models to support low-Greenhouse Gas (GHG) and climate resilient development

ADB estimates suggest that Asia will need investments to the tune of \$1.7 trillion per year from 2016 to 2030 to maintain its growth momentum, eradicate poverty, and respond to climate change.		
Innovative financing models can use development funds, including concessional finance, and financial instruments to encourage private investment in developing countries, markets and sectors that would otherwise be considered too risky, costly or simply not relevant for businesses.		
The intern will explore ADB's experience in using such approaches and will outline the opportunities to use this critical tool to scale up ADB's climate change operations and contribute to related targets of Strategy 2030. Considering ADB's needs and the experience of the intern a country or regional case may be chosen, preferably among Group C (Regular OCR only) developing member countries of ADB.
